This is to inform you that **GG Consulting, LLC** is the sole designer, sole manufacturer, and sole distributor of **I-Suite**, a fully integrated early intervention/intervention management system that includes the following modules: **Special Education Manager™**, **Texas Test Results Reader (TR)^{2™}**, **electronic Student Behavior Intervention Planner (eS-BIP)[™]**, **Student Services and Medicaid Manager (SM)^{2™}**, and **Student Assistance Administration System (SA)²**.

Special Education Manager™, Copyright© 1995-2007, was first released in 1995 as a comprehensive special education management system. It remains the most comprehensive system available to Texas schools. It include fully integrated referral, evaluation, ARD, ITP, and Vocational Assessment forms, more than 110 built-in reports, a custom report generator, automatic PEIMS calculations, and numerous unique functions.

Texas Test Results Reader (TR)^{2™} was released in 2004 and is the only system that fully integrates state test data (TAKS and TELPAS) with special education (via **Special Education Manager**) and other intervention processes. It also includes a custom report builder that integrates state data with intervention program data.

eS-BIP is an extension of **GG Consulting, LLC's** paper product, **Student Behavior Intervention Planner (S-BIP)[™]**, Copyright © 2001-2008, and is the only electronic behavior management system of its type. It creates truly objective functional behavior assessments. It is also the only behavior management system that seamlessly transfers behavior information to and from **Special Education Manager***.

Student Services and Medicaid Manager (SM)² was first released in 2004 and is the only special education and Section 504 service tracking system that addresses both Admission, Review, and Dismissal Committee requirements as defined by IDEA and TEA and all School Health and Related Services program requirements. It assists with scheduling and recording services, creates files needed for district to identify Medicaid eligible students and to file claims, and links directly to **Special Education Manager** for seamless transfer of information to help district ensure that students receive needed services and maximize reimbursements.

Student Assistance Administration System (SA)² is what is I-Suite's early intervention manager. It manages all records for student support teams, Section 504, LPAC, Gifted and Talented, SSI, and PGP. It also has complete Response to Intervention planning and management components and links seamlessly to other **I-Suite** modules.

Although there may be vendors that claim to produce software that manage various components of these systems, to our knowledge, no other vendor has developed such a comprehensive, integrated, and customized set of applications for Texas schools and who keeps the software up-to-date in a timely manner to meet all federal, state, and local requirements. Additionally, there are no vendors who are authorized to support these systems or to create linkages between these systems and other systems (e.g., central student managements systems such as RSCCC).
